Ahmedabad Sees 39% Surge in Lung Cancer Cases

Ahmedabad, Ahmedabad is witnessing a concerning rise in lung cancer cases, with data from the Gujarat Cancer & Research Institute (GCRI) showing a 39% increase in lung cancer cases between 2021 and 2025. During this five-year period, GCRI recorded 4,830 lung cancer cases, with men accounting for the majority of patients. The trend comes against the backdrop of a growing cancer burden across Gujarat. In 2025, the state reported approximately 79,000 new cancer cases and more than 43,500 cancer-related deaths, representing an estimated 10% rise compared with 2021. While these figures highlight the broader challenge, the increase in lung cancer cases in Ahmedabad points to the need for greater focus on prevention, risk assessment and early diagnosis within the city.

Dr Chintan Shah, said, "The rising number of lung cancer cases being seen in Ahmedabad is a matter of concern and reinforces the need for greater awareness around early detection. While tobacco remains a major risk factor, we are also seeing the importance of looking at other exposures and individual risk factors. Persistent cough, breathlessness, chest discomfort, unexplained weight loss or coughing up blood should not be ignored. Individuals at higher risk should discuss appropriate screening and evaluation with their doctor rather than waiting for symptoms to become severe." According to doctors, smoking and tobacco exposure continue to be among the strongest established risk factors for lung cancer. (13-9)

2x surge in M&A deals reflects India Inc's growth ambitions

Ahmedabad, Mergers and acquisitions (M&As) are rapidly evolving from an episodic growth lever into a core strategic tool for driving scale, capability and market leadership across India Inc. This is evident in rising deal volumes, with companies increasingly using acquisitions to scale faster, enter new markets and acquire capabilities that would take longer to build organically. What sets this cycle apart is the stronger credit backdrop supporting deal-making. Moderating organic capex, lower leverage and prudent funding have strengthened balance-sheet flexibility, enhancing companies' ability to absorb acquisition-related risks. The resilience of India Inc has been forged through a volatile operating environment over the past decade, marked by frequent disruptions and shorter recovery cycles. Companies have not only sustained revenue growth and profitability during these periods but also strengthened their balance sheets. Median net debt-to-Ebitda1 for corporates rated by us is estimated at ~1.3 times last fiscal, compared with ~2.4 times in fiscal 2017. At the same time, companies are pursuing organic growth initiatives more selectively amid geopolitical complexities and the resulting demand uncertainties. This reflects a disciplined approach to capital allocation rather than a diminished appetite for growth.

Surat PSI misfiring case, police to bear victim's medical expenses bullet passes through heart, damaged part of small intestine surgically removed

Surat, The condition of 45-year-old truck driver Arvind Patel, who was seriously injured in a missed firing by PSI Makwana while cleaning his service revolver at the Nana Varachha police post in Surat, is now stable. In this case, the Kapodra police, out of humanity, has decided to bear all the hospital expenses of the victim's treatment. Along with this, a case has also been registered against the PSI for negligence. The damaged intestine was removed in an overnight surgery. Arvindbhai was rushed to a private hospital immediately after the incident. The bullet passed under the heart and pierced the stomach, causing serious damage to the small intestine. Doctors performed an urgent and complex surgery between 11:30 pm and 12:00 am and successfully cut and separated the damaged part of the small intestine. Fortunately, the bullet did not cause any damage to the kidneys or the main veins of the body, so the patient is out of danger. Police will bear all medical expenses Kapodra PI M. R. Solanki said that all the medical expenses of Arvindbhai Patel's hospital will be borne by Kapodra Police Department. Apart from this, if he needs treatment or any other assistance in the future, the Police Department will provide full cooperation. was driving a lorry to support his family. The injured Arvindbhai Patel is originally from Kamrej and is financially weak. He drives a hosiery lorry near Nana Varachha Dhal and supports his family with his wife. His married daughter is also working as a jeweler and is supporting the family financially. The family was shocked by this sudden incident, but the family breathed a sigh of relief when the police accepted the responsibility of treatment.

Trump's 'low-key' Iran strategy comes at a high cost



President Donald Trump claimed last week that the US has 'total control over the Strait of Hormuz'. It was immediately rejected by Iranian officials and the Persian Gulf Strait Authority, which asserted that the middle shipping lanes remain mined and blocked, with Tehran controlling the passage. Following Iran's attack on two UAE tankers on Thursday, transit through the chokepoint has come to a grinding halt, with international tracking agencies reporting the movement of just two cargo ships the following day. In the meantime, the Memorandum of Understanding that Trump signed with great fanfare at the Palace of Versailles on June 17 was quietly buried on Sunday without an extension following its initial 60-day period. However, there was some optimism in the first week of this month, when Iran announced that it had finalised arrangements for the administration of the Strait with Oman, a process encouraged by Oman's Gulf partners and the US. While Iran had earlier rejected Oman's proposal for a 50:50 division of maritime traffic accompanied by a voluntary service fee, both sides subsequently considered a 70:30 revenue split. Under this arrangement, Iran would exercise full control over inbound vessels entering the Strait through its territorial waters, while maintaining partial oversight over outbound traffic passing through Omani waters. In addition, discussions included a service fee of \$1 per barrel or \$2 million for large oil tankers, to be split between both sides. But subsequently, Iran hardened its position, asserting that unless the US takes action to lift the blockade and sanctions, stop the war on all fronts, release frozen Iranian assets, pay war reparations, and withdraw its military assets from the vicinity of Iran, it will continue to impose its control over the Strait. While mediators are still continuing the backchannel exchange of messages between the US and Iran, the most recent being the visit of Pakistan's Interior Minister to Tehran last week, Trump has paused US kinetic action, declaring that he is 'low-keying' his approach towards Iran to allow soaring inflation and

severe economic hardship to force Tehran to the negotiating table. In the meantime, Defense Secretary Pete Hegseth announced that the US will maintain its blockade of Iranian ports indefinitely, while Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent declared that he would impose on Iran 'economic isolation like the world has never seen before'. With military operations reaching a plateau and failing to force Iran to yield, along with the critical depletion of US military stockpiles, particularly long-range precision missiles as well as THAAD and Patriot air defence interceptors, the situation has reached a stage where Washington prefers not to escalate the war. The US Navy is also severely overstretched, struggling to provide relief to its naval crews deployed in the region, particularly those aboard the aircraft carrier USS Abraham Lincoln, which is now being relieved by the USS George Washington after an extended deployment of nearly nine months. The fact that Brent crude prices have largely hovered below \$90 per barrel

has also served as an encouraging factor for Washington to maintain its low-key response policy. The US is also betting on its robust domestic production as well as the augmentation of supplies across the Americas, particularly from Canada, Guyana and Venezuela.

However, betting on continued low oil prices is unrealistic. Iran can activate the Houthis in Yemen, who are

already engaged in blockading maritime routes around Saudi Arabia, as well as aligned militias in Iraq, to disrupt shipping through the Red Sea and potentially the Suez Canal, as exemplified by the recent drone strike on the Egyptian Mediterranean port of Damietta. While such disruptions will have an immense adverse impact not only on the Gulf countries but also on the economies of Asia. Trump is perhaps contemplating a domestic 'oil fortress' to assure stable gasoline and diesel prices for domestic consumption, which the administration could enforce by activating statutory regulatory provisions restricting the export of crude oil and refined petroleum products. Even then, Washington would encounter a major structural bottleneck, as US refineries are mainly configured to process heavy crude grades rather than lighter shale oil.
