India's MAHASAGAR moment begins in Seychelles

The three-day state visit of Prime Minister Narendra Modi to Seychelles (June 27-29) marks a watershed moment in the modern history of the Indian Ocean Region. Occurring at the special invitation of Seychellois President Patrick Herminie, the visit coincides with a double milestone: the Golden Jubilee of Seychelles' independence and the commemoration of fifty unbroken years of bilateral diplomatic relations.

Beyond the importance of PM Modi participating as the Guest of Honour at the National Day celebrations, this visit stands as a testament to how two diverse nations bound by a shared colonial past can forge an equal, forward-looking partnership. Through the landmark address by PM Modi to the National Assembly of Seychelles, which represents the first-ever delivered by an Indian PM, India signalled that true strategic friendship is never measured by the geographic size of a nation but by the depth of mutual trust.

At the heart of this diplomatic engagement lies India's evolved maritime doctrine MAHASAGAR (Mutual and Holistic Advancement for Security and Growth Across Regions). Transitioning seamlessly from the initial 2015 SAGAR framework (Security and Growth for All in the Region), MAHASAGAR represents a sophisticated, multidimensional approach to ocean governance. It recognises that maritime safety cannot exist in a vacuum because it is fundamentally intertwined with climate action, ecological sustainability, economic resilience, and digital integration. PM Modi's view that the Indian Ocean binds us in a sphere of peace and prosperity resonated well in Victoria.

Seychelles, though small in land area of 460 square kilometres, commands a colossal Exclusive Economic

Zone spanning over 1.3 million square kilometres. This vast expanse sits adjacent to some of the world's most critical Sea Lines of Communication, carrying the lifeblood of global trade and energy supply chains. India views the safety of Seychelles not as an external foreign policy objective but as an extension of its own coastal security and welfare space.

Rather than allowing the Indian Ocean to degenerate into a contested arena of geopolitical friction, the MAHASAGAR framework seeks to transform it into an ocean of opportunity, ensuring a free, open, and rules-based maritime order.

A crowning glory of this visit was the conferral of the prestigious Guardian of the Blue Horizon presidential distinction upon PM Modi by President Herminie. This rare and high honour is recognition of India's global green leadership, its advancements in the blue economy, and its tireless advocacy for the interests of developing countries within the Global South. While global forums like the Conference of the Parties frequently stall on delivering critical mitigation and adaptation finances to developing countries, India has stepped into the breach. The Guardian of the Blue Horizon award recognises that

India not only preaches climate action but also actively funds and implements it through tangible bilateral efforts to help small island states withstand environmental vulnerabilities.

The visit yielded concrete deliverables by operationalising a robust \$175 million Special Economic Package. This is uniquely structured as a hybrid financing mechanism, blending a \$125 million rupee-denominated Line of Credit with a \$50 million direct grant. Given Seychelles' economic vulnerabilities, the package is calibrated to offer an adequate grant element to the LOC so that it may be absorbed over time, and Rupee disbursements will be made in India. In a pivotal gesture, India handed over an array of advanced operational assets to the Seychelles People's Defence Forces, including a made-in-India Fast Patrol Vessel, five high-speed laser-guided boats, six state-of-the-art medical ambulances, and ten heavy-duty utility vehicles. These bolster Seychelles' capability to manage its EEZ against asymmetric threats. While the primary maritime threat in the early 2010s was piracy, contemporary challenges revolve around illegal, unreported, and unregulated (IUU) fishing, narcotics

trafficking, and climate-induced natural disasters. Backed by India's previous gifting of two Dornier maritime surveillance aircraft and the installation of the Coastal Surveillance Radar System, Seychelles' security infrastructure is now deeply integrated with Indian technical expertise, ensuring rapid-response HADR capabilities. A new request for an ALH will be positively considered by India.

The visit saw the signing of nine crucial bilateral agreements that establish a robust framework for long-term collaboration. Chief among these was a landmark Extradition Treaty. As Seychelles expands its footprint as a major financial services hub in the region, this treaty serves as a legal safeguard, ensuring that nefarious characters cannot exploit the island's financial systems to evade justice. Simultaneously, the two nations broke ground on a new Professional and Technical Training Institution and initiated plans for a specialized hospital. These projects could be funded through the economic package, which focuses on capacity building and upgrading the skills of the Seychellois people to thrive in a service-dominated economy. Looking toward the horizon, the India-Seychelles partnership is venturing into



cutting-edge frontiers. The introduction of India's globally acclaimed Digital Public Infrastructure, modeled around the Unified Payments Interface, is set to revolutionize financial inclusivity and e-governance across the archipelago. Economically, the relationship is moving past donor-recipient dynamics toward a dynamic hybrid investment ecosystem. If government-backed lines of credit are combined with private-sector capital, major avenues may open for

sustainable tuna processing for direct export to global markets and for expanding tourism infrastructure through enhanced maritime and aviation connectivity. The living bridge of the 15000-strong Indian diaspora, comprising deeply integrated Indo-Seychellois communities and professionals, continues to breathe vibrant cultural life into this strategic alliance.

Heavy rains in many parts of Saurashtra

Gir Somnath In Gujarat, Meghrajha has started battling with a bang across Saurashtra since the beginning of July. In the last 24 hours, Meghrajha has occurred in 107 talukas of the state, in which water-logging has been created due to heavy rains in Junagadh, Rajkot, Amreli and Gir Somnath.

Subtrapada in Gir Somnath district received 4 inches of rain in just three hours and Una-Kodinar received 1 to 1.5 inches of rain in two hours, turning fields into swamps. On one hand, there is a great

misery to the elderly, and the poor and needy. Water entered the Shiva temple.

The Meteorological Department has issued an alert warning of heavy to very heavy rains until July 5, with wind speeds of 40 to 50 kilometers per hour, and the administration has also been ordered to be prepared. New water has come into the rivers in the rural areas of Ranpur taluka of Botad. Scenes of rivers flowing in the streets due to heavy rain in Alampur village. Rain fell in villages including Kundli, Bubi, Rajpara, Panvi, Alampur in Ranpur taluka. The river in Alampur village flooded, while new water came into the Bhadr river in Naganesh village. Farmers were happy as good rain was suitable for sowing. Unseasonal rains have been recorded in Keshod city and surrounding rural areas of Junagadh district. Due to this universal rain, there has been a huge influx of new water in the rivers of the rural parish. The famous Noli river of Keshod has flowed on both banks due to the heavy flow of water.
