As Immunisation Coverage Reaches 98.4%, IHMR University Calls for Greater Adult Vaccination Awareness Jaipur : With India achieving significant milestones in immunisation coverage and Rajasthan emerging as a success story in preventive healthcare, health experts are now shifting focus towards the importance of adult vaccination. The issue took centre stage at an awareness session on "Adult Vaccination" organised by IHMR University under its "Let's Talk About Health" initiative. According to data shared on National Vaccination Day 2026, immunisation coverage in Rajasthan increased dramatically from 21.1 per cent in 1992-93 to 91.8 per cent in 2024-25. The state has also remained polio-free since 2009, reflecting the success of sustained public health efforts. Nationally, full immunisation coverage has risen from 62 per cent in 2015 to 98.4 per cent by January 2026, highlighting the growing reach of preventive healthcare programmes. The session featured Dr. Sudhir Bhandari, Pro-Chancellor and Senior Professor at Jaipur National University Institute for Medical Sciences and former Vice-Chancellor of Rajasthan University of Health Sciences. Addressing participants, Dr. Bhandari emphasized that while childhood immunisation has seen remarkable progress, many adults remain vulnerable to preventable diseases due to missed booster doses and limited awareness. He highlighted the importance of vaccines against influenza, shingles and pneumococcal infections in strengthening immunity and reducing health risks. Speaking at the event, Dr. P.R. Sodani said preventive healthcare is becoming increasingly important in today's evolving healthcare landscape. He noted that vaccination remains one of the most cost-effective public health interventions and has played a vital role in reducing infectious diseases, lowering child mortality and eliminating illnesses such as polio and maternal-neonatal tetanus in India. Hosted in partnership with GSK, the programme encouraged discussions on vaccine awareness, preventive healthcare practices and the need for evidence-based health communication, while highlighting adult immunisation as the next important step in strengthening India's public health framework.

Central University of Rajasthan Launches Research Promotion Scheme for Ph.D. Scholars Ajmer, Rajasthan : The Central University of Rajasthan (CURAJ) has launched the Vice-Chancellor (CURAJ) Research Promotion Scheme (VCRPS) for Ph.D. scholars admitted from the 2025 academic session onwards. Introduced under the leadership of Vice-Chancellor Prof. Anand Bhalerao, the initiative aims to strengthen research culture and provide financial support to scholars pursuing doctoral studies. The scheme has been specifically designed for Non-NET fellowship research scholars. Under VCRPS, eligible scholars will receive an additional financial assistance of Rs. 5,000 per month over and above the existing UGC Non-NET fellowship. They will also be provided a contingency grant of Rs. 10,000 to support research-related activities and expenses. Prof. Anand Bhalerao said the initiative was introduced after observing that the existing Non-NET fellowship often falls short of meeting scholars' academic and living expenses. He noted that the scheme would encourage meritorious students to pursue research while promoting innovation, academic excellence and knowledge creation. According to the scheme, scholars will continue to receive the regular UGC Non-NET fellowship of Rs. 8,000 per month during the first semester. The additional support will begin from the second semester, while continuation from the third semester onwards will depend on annual performance reviews. Research scholars receiving support under VCRPS will be required to continue at the university for a minimum of three years. The initiative is expected to significantly boost research output and strengthen CURAJ's vision of becoming a leading centre for academic excellence, innovation and socially relevant research.

IIT Jodhpur Scientists Build Futuristic 'Wonder Materials' Atom by Atom; Research Opens New Possibilities for Energy, Smart Sensors and Self-Glowing Roads Jodhpur : Researchers at IIT Jodhpur are pushing the boundaries of materials science by engineering advanced materials at the atomic scale, paving the way for innovations in energy storage, environmental sensing, smart infrastructure and next-generation electronics. At the forefront of this work is the NanoSense Lab, led by Dr. Pranay Ranjan from the Department of Metallurgical and Materials Engineering. The team is developing futuristic two-dimensional (2D) materials—ultra-thin substances only a few atoms thick—that possess remarkable electrical, optical and mechanical properties. Among the lab's most significant achievements is its research on borophene, one of the world's lightest and most promising 2D materials. Unlike graphene, borophene is intrinsically metallic and extremely lightweight, making it highly suitable for high-performance batteries, supercapacitors, advanced gas sensors and nanoelectronic devices. The team has successfully synthesized borophene as a freestanding 2D material, marking an important milestone in materials research. The researchers are also studying advanced materials such as hematene, graphene and graphene oxide for applications in hydrogen generation, spintronics, protective coatings and electronic systems. Moving beyond laboratory-scale discoveries, the NanoSense Lab is actively pursuing "Lab-to-Fab" translation to transform scientific breakthroughs into commercially viable technologies. To support large-scale production, the lab has established a strategic collaboration with the Tata Group's New Materials Division for the indigenous development and manufacturing of advanced materials for sectors including defence, electronics and energy storage. One of the lab's most innovative developments is a self-glowing paint created in collaboration with Marudhar Paints and Polymers. The paint absorbs sunlight during the day and emits a visible glow at night without requiring electricity or batteries. The technology has potential applications in road safety infrastructure, highway dividers, public spaces and emergency signage. The NanoSense Lab is also developing highly sensitive borophene-based gas sensors under a project supported by the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology. These sensors can detect hazardous gases through minute changes in electrical resistance, offering promising applications in industrial safety, environmental monitoring, healthcare and smart cities. By combining fundamental research with industry collaboration and technology transfer, IIT Jodhpur is positioning itself at the forefront of next-generation materials science. The institute's innovations are expected to contribute significantly to India's ambitions in advanced manufacturing, clean energy and deep-tech self-reliance.
